Gender Equality in Ageing Societies in Asia

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Characteristics of older women

- Women have longer life expectancy than men (5-7 years)
- More women among older old (more frail/vulnerable)
- More likely to be widowed, single
- Living longer but more sick years not compressed morbidity but expanded morbidity
- Changing epidemiology /disease pattern non communicable diseases, dementia, women-related
- Deaths later in life care needs (long term care, home –based, nursing homes, palliative care)
- Lower education, lower labour force participation, part time work, curtail career for caregiving – lower economic independence /inadequate savings for old age
- Discrimination /ageism/violence through life cycle

Situation in Asia

- Family support and filial piety still strong in Asian countries although eroding
- Intergenerational transfers e.g. Japan, Korea,
- Reciprocity /social exchange (grandparenting)
- Asian economic progress greater propensity to save and invest
- Governments better able to provide infrastructure and social services, digital/tech savvy
- More adoption of anti-discriminatory laws and regulations and governance entities

Action needed for older women

Health Security

- Lifecourse approach :Health promotion/prevention /rehabilitative/ curative
- Community-based care (eg. Sgp "Many Helping Hands", Philippines, Indonesia – gotong royong)
- Support/capacity building for health personnel/care givers (usually female)
- Towards universal health coverage for basic package
- Reduce male death rate (eg higher risk behaviour, smoking, occupational safety)

Action needed for Older Women

Economic Security

- Towards access to a social pension (citizens income) eg Thailand, VietNam, Sgp Silver Support
- Employability of older women, review retirement age
- Retraining/reskilling/lifelong learning eg Hong Kong Elder Academy, Sgp SkillsFutureCredit
- Review/expand formal pension system to include selfemployed, payment by family members eg. Sgp CPF Top-up, spousal survivorship benefit

Action needed for Older Women

Enabling Environment

- Incentives to strengthen the family (tax incentives, housing priority/coresidence, intergenerational bonding etc eg Sgp Maintenance of Parent Act)
- Older persons as resource/contributor, not burden mind set change (Sgp Pioneer Generation Package)
- Gender equality pervasive in society eg Nordic countries
- Global support and mandates -CEDAW reporting, ILO Social Protection Floor, post 2015 agendas, Sustainable Development Goals,
